

Rules and regulations Bike Kingdom Hunt 2025

1. Scope of application

The following regulations apply to the Bike Kingdom Hunt Arosa from 11 - 13 July 2025 in Arosa/Lenzerheide (GR).

2. Date

Friday, 11 July 2025 to Sunday, 13 July 2025

3. Eligibility / Registration

A team consists of 2 or 3 riders. You must be at least 18 years old to participate. Exception: if a team consists of a legal guardian and a participant of at least 12 years of age.

With the payment of the entry fee you fully accept all conditions of participation of the organiser (Arosa Tourism).

The registration takes place via the website <u>bikekingdom.com/hunt</u>. Late registrations are possible on site.

Before the event you will receive an e-mail with the detailed programme and the briefing and start times.

A refund of the participation fee is only possible in case of cancellation or postponement of the Bike Kingdom Hunt. In particular, the participation fee will not be refunded in the event of non-attendance, late arrival and exclusion of the participant from the event or violation of the provisions of these regulations. A refund of the participation fee is only possible on presenting a medical certificate.

4. Participation fee

The participation fee is CHF 190.00 per team of two. Teams of three pay CHF 285.00. Payment is made after registration by bank transfer or Twint. The participation fee includes:

- Event participation incl. trail map
- Day ticket mountain railways for the event day
- Event shirt
- Participation in event raffle or starter bag with goodies
- Dinner incl. 1 drink for Saturday evening
- Free test possibility Sunday (depending on availability Event Bike Partner)
- Discounted day ticket Sunday



5. Categories

There are a total of 8 categories:

- 1. advanced:
 - 1.1. enduro (men, women, mixed)
 - 1.2. e-mountain bike (unisex)

2. intermediates

2.1. enduro (men, women, mixed)

2.2. e-mountain bike (unisex)

6. Check-In / Start number distribution

Check-in and start number distribution will take place the day before at the event site in Arosa from 18.00 to 20.00 hrs. On race day the start numbers will be handed out from 08.30 to 09.45 hrs at the Event Village, Aves Sonnendeck Ochsenbühl in Arosa.

The start number must be attached to the handlebars of the bike in a clearly visible position and may not be altered. The liability waiver must be signed at check-in/start number issue. By signing the liability waiver you accept the regulations of the Bike Kingdom Hunt 2025.

7. The race - the mission - the ranking/scoring

Races are in teams of 2 or 3 in the respective categories.

The Advanced categories: complete all challenges and control stations (in Arosa Lenzerheide).

The Intermediates categories: Complete all challenges and 4 control stations (in Arosa).

Each team receives the Mission Pass (Mission Pass = trail map with the respective number of control points in the Arosa Lenzerheide region and the integrated stamp card) at the Riders Briefing. All challenges and control stations listed in the mission pass are considered checkpoints. The passport must be stamped at each station.

The route can be determined independently by each team. At the end, all stamps must be entered in the mission pass, depending on the category. The race mainly takes place above 2,000 m above sea level, so please bring warm clothing.

The race will be started in a Le Mans start format.

The fastest teams per category (Advanced Enduro, Advanced E-Mountainbike and Intermediates Enduro, Intermediates E-Mountainbike) will win. However, the main prize will go to the team that is closest to the average time of all participating teams. The Dead Last Loser team will receive a special prize at the ranking ceremony.

The race is scheduled to end at 18.00 hrs. All teams that arrive later at the finish will not be scored and will appear as DNF in the ranking list.



8. Equipment

Only all types of mountain bikes including e-mountain bikes are permitted. Other bikes such as gravel and cross bikes or bikes with traditional, curved road handlebars or time trial and triathlon handlebar attachments etc. are not permitted.

Helmets must be worn by all participants.

The wearing of further protective equipment such as back, knee, elbow protectors etc. is permitted or recommended.

9. Riders Briefing

At the Riders Briefing you will be given your mission passes and the last relevant information about the Bike Kingdom Hunt 2025. The Rider Briefing will take place at 10:00 in the Start and Finish area. Attendance is compulsory for all participants. Failure to attend will result in disqualification.

10. Behaviour on the trail & fair trail

The provisions of the Road Traffic Act (SVG) apply on the route. The route is not closed. There may be hikers or other "road users" on the trails at any time. All participants start at their own risk. The organiser, Arosa Tourism, accepts no liability for accidents or other damage before, during or after the event (not even to or by third parties). The instructions of the executive and officials must be obeyed. Undisciplined participants will be removed from the ranking list and disqualified. In case of punishable offences against the SVG, the personal data of the participants will be forwarded to the authorities.

The fun and the common trail experience are in the foreground. If necessary, you will help other teams or participants in need. Littering will result in disqualification and a ban for the following year.

11.Lifts

Only the mountain railways are considered as ascent aids. The e-bike category is only allowed to use selected mountain railways as an ascent aid. You will get detailed information at the riders briefing before the start. Cars, buses, etc. are prohibited. The uphill on the Flowtrail Hörnli Trail is strictly forbidden and will be punished with immediate disqualification in case of non-compliance.

12. Award Ceremony

The award ceremony is part of the event and will take place after the race at 6:30 pm at the Event Village, Aves Sonnendeck Ochsenbühl in Arosa.

13. passing on or transfer of the starting place

It is possible to transfer the already paid starting place to another person/s after consultation with the organiser Arosa Tourismus.



14. Cancellation

If you are prevented from attending, there is no entitlement to a refund. In case of illness, please contact the organiser Arosa Tourismus. In any case, a medical certificate must be presented.

15. Granting of rights

With your registration for the Bike Kingdom Hunt 2025, you confirm that professional photo and video recordings will be made during the sporting event "Bike Kingdom Hunt 2025, 11 - 13 July 2025 in Arosa Lenzerheide". You agree that the photo and video recordings made, including the rights to the image and sound, are transferred to Arosa Tourimus. The rights include the unrestricted, temporally, locally and formally unlimited publication, also for advertising purposes of any kind, data carriers and other storage media. Arosa Tourism is the sole copyright holder. In the event of publication, participants shall not make any further claims, including against third parties (e.g. publishers, providers, webmasters). With your registration you also agree that your personal and address data as well as results may be stored and processed by computer, that your name, year of birth, place of residence and team may be published in the starter and result lists on the Internet, in the newspaper and in notices, and that your address data may be used for advertising purposes by the organiser.

16. Liability and abandonment of the race

Participation in the event is at the participant's own risk. Insurance cover is the responsibility of the participants. With your registration you confirm that you have a valid accident and liability insurance. With your participation you confirm that your mountain bike is safe to use. Any liability of the organiser is limited to intent and gross negligence and is completely excluded in all other respects. The organiser excludes any liability for auxiliary persons. If, in the opinion of the organiser, the Bike Kingdom Hunt is jeopardised by force majeure, the organiser reserves the right to cancel, terminate or abandon the event without responsibility or liability for the amount or nature of any loss or damage which may be caused directly or indirectly to any participant.

17. Changes

The organiser reserves the right to make changes to the programme. All official changes and announcements will be communicated and posted on our website <u>bikekindom.com/hunt</u>.
